

PREREQUISITIES for PHRN

Participants must provide current documentation of the following :

- **Registered Nurse in Illinois**
- **Current CPR for Healthcare Provider**
- **Current ACLS**
- **Current Trauma Certification (TNCC/ TNS / ITLS / PHTLS)**
- **Current Pediatric Certification (ENPC/ PEPP/PALS)**

Course Completion Requirements

To become licensed as a PHRN through the State of Illinois, the student must:

- Successfully complete the PHRN Course
- Pass the PAEMS Protocol Exam. Minimum passing score is 80%. This will be given at the end of the 2nd day of the course.
- Complete a rotation in the OSF St. Francis Medical Center OR with 8 successful intubations
- Complete a minimum of 120 hours of ride time with documented 25 ALS calls. Field training must be done under the supervision of an approved PAEMS Field Training Instructor within 180 days of course completion.

PHRN Curriculum Preface

The PHRN is a healthcare professional who demonstrates an understanding of pre-hospital emergency medical services. PHRN candidates completing this curriculum will have successfully demonstrated entry-level competency in basic and advanced life support theory, inclusive of scene safety issues, field patient assessment, field patient management with continuous field monitoring, radio communication skills, basic and advanced life support psychomotor skills and field transportation issues.

This revised 'PHRN curriculum redefines the scope of responsibility of the PHRN and redirects the basic information to a pre-hospital environment. PHRNs function under medical control authorization in a pre-hospital environment, working in conjunction with other pre-hospital practitioners to competently and emergently care for the patient. A critical intent of this revised curriculum is to have the registered nurse integrate pathophysiological principles with patient assessment findings to formulate a field impression, leading to the implementation of a treatment plan utilizing the Pre-hospital System Protocols.

The PHRN Curriculum is designed to address topics pertinent to the pre-hospital emergency care of the critically ill and injured patient and reflects the current objectives of the National Standard Curriculum as identified by the National Highway Traffic Safety Association.

The practice of a PHRN requires a unique body of knowledge, incorporating nursing knowledge with pre-hospital emergency medical care. PHRNs need to adhere to established standards of practice in addition to the application of a specific body of emergency medical services

The registration fee is \$250.00 which includes course materials. Please get the latest copy of your systems protocol as you will be taking your protocol exam during the class.

You must pass at the highest level in your system. If your internship will be in the *Peoria Area EMS System* you will take the *PAEMS ALS Exam*.
